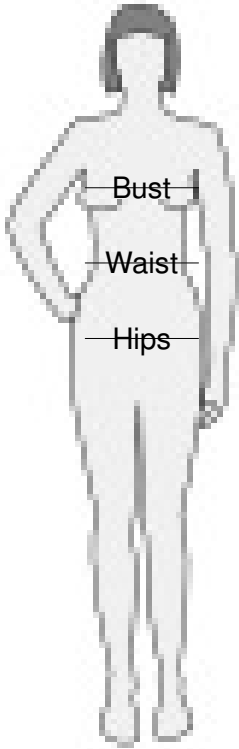


How To Measure Guidelines



How to get your measurements:

1. **Bust:** Measure the fullest part of your bust.
2. **Waist:** Measure 1.5" above your belly button.
3. **Hips:** Measure the fullest part of you hips.

"To get the best possible measurements have a friend help you."

Of course the final decision and responsibility on what size to order is, of course, up to you, our customer. Gowns are special order items and cannot be returned or exchanged. Please be aware that sizing is not an exact science and alterations by an experienced seamstress will almost always be necessary for a proper fit. Almost all of our customers need some type of alterations

All of the vendors on our website have a size chart under the size chart tab; be sure to order the gown size according to your measurements on the vendor size chart.

Things to know: Gowns fit smaller than regular clothes. At least one size smaller. To get the best fit for your body, have a friend measure your carefully and use the size chart.

You can always take up a gown that is a little large, but you cannot let out a gown that is too small. Error on the side of caution.

The gowns are long enough to fit girls 5'8", however, many of our vendors offer "Extra Length" gowns for those that are taller than 5'8". Measure carefully and match your dimensions to the size chart.

Note: Each vendor uses a different size chart so you will not be able to assume that a size 8 from Mori Lee will fit the same way a size 8 from Raylia does.

All gowns are hemmed (even beaded gowns). All gowns can be taken in at the side seams or the seam at the back. Often gowns must be taken in at the straps to fit properly, especially for those that are short waisted.

***Measuring Guidelines to determine your size is simple:
DO NOT MEASURE YOURSELF***

Bust: measure around the widest part of the back, straight across the fullest part of the bust, do not measure under the bust line. Please be aware that wearing no bra versus a strapless or regular bra can make quite a difference in measurements. DO NOT use your bra size measurement since a 34A is a big difference from 34D.

Please also remember that the time of the month you are measured can cause bust line measurements to fluctuate.

Waist: measure around your natural waistline. Make sure you are not holding your stomach in while you take this measurement. Leave one finger under the measuring tape so that the tape can be moved. You do not want to give us a skin tight measurement.

Hips: measure around the fullest part of the hip. Put your thumbs at your natural waist as rest your hands on your hips. The tip of your fingers should be the area to measure for your hips.

Extra Length: Extra length is available for most gowns and should be strongly considered if you are over 5'8" tall. Check with us on what the length of the gown should be and consider the heel height being worn.

{Hollow to Hem-Measurements if from the hollow in the throat to the floor.}
